ABOUT LAVA CAP

Founded in 1981, Lava Cap Winery is a third generation family farm, located in the Sierra Foothills, at an elevation of 2,700ft. The winery and Estate Vineyards are located on a unique outcropping of volcanic soil, the inspiration for the wineries name. The result of elevation and distinct soils are wines that errupt with flavor.

VINEYARD NOTES

Lava Cap sourced grapes from 2 vineyards for our 2018
Petite Sirah, both of which consistently produce highly
decorated Petite Sirah. The first is planted in
decomposed granitic loam, which forces the roots to dive
deep for water and nutrients. This hilltop location with
dramatic views of the Crystal Range of the Sierra
Nevada Mountains also sits in the path of cool air
streaming down the American River Canyon, allowing the
grapes to develop complexity during a lengthy growing
season. The second site grows in decomposed, iron-rich
slate, the perfect medium for a low yield and high stress
vineyard, resulting in grapes of intense dark-fruit
flavors

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2018 Petite Sirah combines these two sites to showcase notes of licorice, blueberries, and clove. The wine enters the palate with flavors of plum and white pepper, which perfectly transitions to fine tannins and long elegant finish.
